The National Donations Management Network (NDMN) program is powered by the Aidmatrix Network®. It serves State governments and State Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (VOADs) and includes a winning combination of technology, partnership and community. The goal is to reduce the time-consuming manual processes involved in disaster relief and increase the flow-through rate of unsolicited, quality donations to those in need. The net result is more people get helped more quickly.

The **technology** addresses the State's primary responsibility to collect donation information and to share it with those involved in the disaster response. It provides an easy-to-use web portal that captures the information online, ready to be shared securely with VOAD members 24x7. It manages four key areas of disaster response: In-Kind Donations, Volunteers, Warehouse, and Financial Donations Referral. It takes no additional IT staff or computer hardware to operate. All you need is a web-browser, basic Internet skills and about one-half hour for basic user training.

- Enable VOAD members to view, post and accept offers online, 24x7
- Comprehensive dashboard reporting
- Quickly connect donors wanting to make unsolicited cash gifts with VOAD partners
- No software or IT staff required (SaaS)
